Building Project

Greetings to all! Please see the insert regarding the ongoing work on the building project. If you look at the church area itself, you will notice that the choir has been moved to the left transept and that the baptism font has its own unique location. Confessionals are on the opposite side. The exact shape of the baptistery's walls have yet to be determined. The configuration of the reconciliation rooms, too, are yet to be determined as we are waiting on diocesan comment, but the location will be as shown. A ramp is now included on the left side that wraps around toward the ambo. In the nave of the church (where all the pews are located) you will see black dots, those are columns. Since this latest draft, the columns will be just a little bit closer to the exterior walls to assist air circulation.

For the site itself, you will notice that the entire facility is now at a slight angle and that handicap parking has been moved closer to the church via the adoration chapel on the north side. Future parking has been sketched in.

In addition to the above, the various parishioners have gotten together with the architect and building committee to go over the details of the kitchen, office space, and partly the choir area. Those details were just discussed at the last meeting two weeks ago and will be included in updated later updated drawings. This particular stage is called Design Development.

Be mindful that these drawings are continuing to be revisited and redrawn. Details continue to be discussed.
